WMAS TROPHIES

Ladies Cup: Highest Recurve Score
Gents Shield: Highest Recurve Score
Junior Trophy: Highest Recurve Score (any age group)
WMAS are trying to find trophies to award for Compound & Longbow as well this year.

WMAS & OPEN MEDALS

Medals will be awarded in each class (Recurve, Compound, Longbow) and age and gender group according to the entry as follows:-

1 to 3 Archers: 1st Only
4 to 5 Archers: 1st and 2nd
6 or more Archers: 1st, 2nd and 3rd

ROUNDS

Western rounds are made up of eight dozen arrows, four dozen at each of the following distances:-

Western: 60 & 50 yards (Gents, Ladies, Boys under 18)
Short Western: 50 & 40 yards (Girls under 18 and Boys under 16)
Junior Western: 40 & 30 yards (Girls under 16 and Boys under 14)
Short Junior Western: 30 & 20 yards (Girls under 14 and Boys under 12)

Ages are at the date of the Tournament, NOT the date of entry.

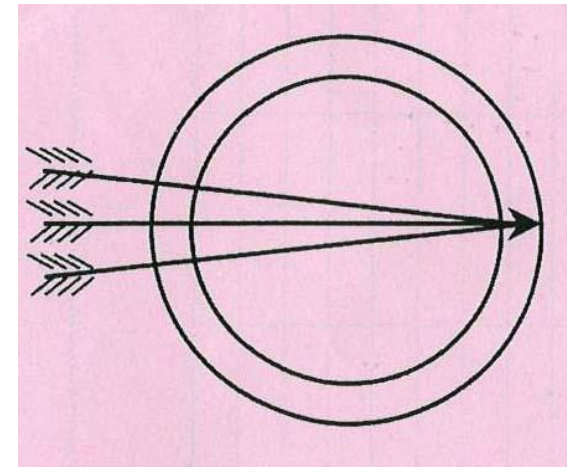
