Venue: Ironbridge Power Station Sports ground, Much Wenlock Road, Buildwas, Telford, TF8 7BP

Round: Western, 4 dozen @ 60 yds + 4 dozen @ 50 yds. **No other distances will be shot.**

The round will be shot to GNAS rules and will qualify for National record status.

Dress regulations will be enforced.

Styles – compound, recurve freestyle, barebow, longbow, AFB & Traditional

Note Traditional means a wooden bow such as a Mongolian or Scythian type bow shooting wooden arrows with feather fletchings conforming to GNAS rule 205.

Judges: Tony Goad + others TBA

Lady Paramount: To be appointed by the Wenlock Olympian Committee

Sighters: 11am, Sunday 10th July 2011

Entry Fees: Senior £7, Junior £4.

Please send 2 x SAE's with your entry or specify an email address if you wish to receive a target list and a results sheet. Space is limited, so please get your entries in early. Entries will be accepted on a first come first served basis and cannot be accepted on the day of the shoot.

Directions

The shoot will be held at the Ironbridge Power Station Recreation Ground 3 miles from the Linden Fields on the A4169.

The sports ground is where the A4169 crosses the River Severn (by the C in Coalbrookdale on the map).
