

Bowbrook Archers Sword of Shrewsbury 2012

The Sword of Shrewsbury is 3 competitions in one. Separate prizes are awarded for clout and National but the overall winner is the archer who does best in both disciplines (clout & target). Archers are ranked according to their performance in each event and the rankings added together. The archer with the lowest number of ranking points is the overall champion. The Sword of Shrewsbury is awarded to the Gents champion while the Ladies dagger is awarded to the Lady champion.

Archers are considered to be part of the kings army when shooting the first clout and part of the rebel army when shooting the second clout. The total scores for the 2 clouts are added together to determine whether the king or rebels won the Battle of Shrewsbury. The Battle of Shrewsbury in 1403 was the second bloodiest battle fought on English soil and was one of only 2 battles where longbows were used by both sides, the other being Towton. Henry Percy (Hotspur) led a rebel army trying to overthrow King Henry IV. Part of the kings army was led by prince Henry (later Henry V) and it is thought that this is where he learned to use longbow archers so effectively at Agincourt and other battles during the Hundred years war.

Clout

Under BLBS rules the winner is the person with the highest score for the double clout. 2nd is the archer with the highest score for the first clout (the first 3 dozen arrows). 3rd is the archer with the highest score for the second clout (the last 3 dozen arrows). We then rank archers according to their score and use this later to determine the overall winner. Where 2 archers have the same score we use number of hits as a tie break when determining ranking.

Overall Position

The winner is the archer with the lowest combined rank ie the one who did best in both events.
